Position Summary

Clinton College seeks a dynamic and student-centered individual to join the Division of Business as a full-time Sports Management Faculty member. This position involves teaching, curriculum development, student advising, and industry engagement to prepare students for successful sports, recreation, and entertainment careers. The faculty member will contribute to the academic excellence, mission, and core values of a historically Black college/university (HBCU).

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

Teach a standard full-time faculty course load in Sports Management each semester (including Sports Marketing, Event Management, Sports Law, and Facility Management).

- Develop and update curriculum in alignment with industry standards, accreditation requirements, and best practices in higher education.
- Advise Sports Management majors on academic planning, degree completion, and career preparation.
- Supervise and support student internships, ensuring alignment with learning outcomes and professional standards.
- Establish relationships with sports organizations, teams, venues, and community partners to create experiential learning opportunities.
- Participate in departmental and college-wide committees, assessment activities, and accreditation processes.

- Organize and support student engagement initiatives, including guest speakers, networking events, and professional development workshops.
- Maintain active professional development to remain current with trends, technologies, and innovations in the sports industry.
- Contribute to program growth, recruitment activities, and marketing of the Sports Management program.

Minimum Qualifications

- Master's degree in Sports Management, Sports Administration, Business Administration, or a related field from a regionally accredited institution.
- Demonstrated college-level teaching experience (face-to-face and/or online).
- Strong communication, organizational, and collaboration skills.

Preferred Qualifications

- Doctorate in Sports Management, Sports Administration, or a closely related field.
- Significant professional experience within the sports industry.
- Experience in academic advising and supervision of internships.
- Evidence of scholarly or professional contributions to the field.

Working Conditions

- Full-time, 10-month faculty appointment with the possibility of summer teaching.
- Primarily on-campus position with occasional travel for conferences, recruitment, or partnership development.
